Together, we can ensure every child in Southwest Virginia receives the treatment and care they deserve.



Carilion Children's and the Life Ring Foundation share the mutual goal of enhancing and growing cancer services for children in Southwest Virginia and desire to collaborate through a philanthropic financial partnership. 




To increase the capacity and accessibility so all children of the region, and beyond, have access to the best cancer care closest to where they live.

#### **Fundraiser**

We spent most of our resources on the biggest event of the year, Charlotte's Play Yellow Invitational. We hit our goal (\$1.4 million) and also found new partners & donors to work with – invaluable!

#### **New staff**

Our 1st full-time employee started in August 2023. Jordan Bousman is the VP of Philanthropy. We are very grateful for her commitment to the cause and leadership.

#### The FKC T-Shirt Club

We launched a new recurring donor campaign, the Fighting Kids Cancer T-Shirt Club. It offers the opportunity to contribute in a smaller gift capacity monthly and receive recognition (and a cool shirt).

#### **DID YOU KNOW?**

The Name Origin of "The Life Ring Foundation?" "When someone is in open water and cannot swim anymore, we throw a life ring to help them."



Life Ring has sponsored the Roanoke Baby book since 2014 to be given complimentary to every baby born at Carilion Roanoke Memorial Hospital.

In support of literacy education and in partnership with Roanoke Public Libraries, "Roanoke Baby" is now bilingual and has distributed over 23, 282 copies (~2,400 copies per year!).





Pediatric Cancer & blood disorders threaten the most precious things in life you will ever have...your children. Diagnosis is a blindside catastrophe you could never be and should never be prepared for. When it happens, it is shattering and terrifying. There are no words to describe these feelings. A parent is not built to see their children suffer. The torment of watching the disease burden take it's toll on your baby is gutting. Worse still, sometimes the treatments can be more tolling and painful than the disease itself. Fighting pediatric disease is an unnatural journey that injures and scars the entire family, the village, and is something everyone must take on.

While there is no way to describe the heartbreaking, gut-wrenching and even miraculous journey that fighting cancer can bring, there are no people more equipped to try than the warriors, parents and family of those who have walked the path. The stories of battle that follow, are those of the heroes who fought them. Some are stories of miracles while others are echoes of the lives of heroes who have been set free from the pain and suffering of this world.

#### **Childhood Cancer**

- Approximately 1 in 285 children in the U.S. will be diagnosed with cancer before their 20th birthday. Globally there are more than 300,000 children diagnosed with cancer each year.
- Every 3 minutes, somewhere in the world a family hears the devastating words that their child has been diagnosed with cancer.
- Cancer is the leading cause of death by disease in American children, resulting in the death of approximately 1,800 kids each year.
- Two-thirds of those who do survive face at least one chronic health condition.
  One quarter of survivors face a late-effect from treatment that is classified as
  severe or life-threatening. Late-effects of treatment can include heart damage,
  second cancers, lung damage, infertility, cognitive impairment, growth deficits,
  hearing loss, and more. It is becoming increasingly apparent that childhood
  cancer "is for life."
- Childhood cancer research is consistently underfunded. Less than 4% of the U.S. federal budget for cancer research is dedicated to childhood cancer.
